Approval of Minutes from the Previous Meeting

The minutes of the Regular adjourned meeting of the Board of Directors held on November 28, 2022, were approved on a motion by Director Swartfager and seconded by Director Noack by a vote of 4 to 0.

OLD BUSINESS

A. Update – Farr West Engineering

SCADA is almost complete. There have been a few delays. The original enclosure was not rated for harsh weather. The correct enclosure will be shipped in January. Liberty Energy will inspect the transformer to check for the correct capacity needed to maintain the district equipment, they will replace the transformer if necessary.

B. <u>TCPUD Interconnection Agreement update</u>

TCPUD added the Tahoma Meadows intertie as part of the agreement. McKinney Water District and TCPUD are in agreement to abandon the Hilo Intertie. The agreement was updated to include historical items and added an agreement to move to Stage 3 water rationing if either entity uses the intertie.

On a motion by Director Swartfager and Seconded by Director Dangler, the Board approved the amended and restated Interconnection Agreement by a vote of 4 to 0.

A. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>

The Board accepted the Treasurer's Report as presented for the month of November 2022 totaling - **\$884,694.35**

B. <u>Bills/Charges and Transfers</u>
