#### **Approval of Minutes from the Previous Meeting**

The minutes of the Regular adjourned meeting of the Board of Directors, held December 24, 2021, was approved on a motion by Director Swartfager and seconded by Director Noack by a vote of 5 to 0.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### A. Update for Farr West – Quote for VFD and Upcoming Design Work

District Agent discussed the Proposal to Upgrade the starting pump system. (Task 1). Bid Support Services to provide plans and a bid-ready package. (Task 2) Farr West will perform as the Construction Manager for the project (Task 3). On a motion from Director Swartfager and seconded by Director Noack, the Board

has voted 5 to 0, to implement Tasks 1, 2, and 3.

#### **B.** Sierra Controls to provide SCADA Quote

The District Agent discussed the Cloud SCADA upgrade with the Board of Directors. On a motion from Director Swartfager and seconded by Director Noack, the Board approved the SCADA upgrade proposal from Sierra Controls totaling \$34.947.92 on a vote of 5 to 0.

#### C. Update – Umpqua Bank

The Umpqua Savings Account is now funded with \$150,000.00. Transferred \$50,000.00 each from, Bank of the West Savings, El Dorado Savings, and US Bank Savings accounts.

#### A. Treasurer's Report

The Board accepted the Treasurer's Report as presented for the month of December 2021 totaling - \$787,678.23

#### B. Bills/Charges and Transfers

The Board reviewed the January 2022 Bills and Charges totaling \$10,167.46. On a motion of Director Swartfager and seconded by Director Noack the bills and charges were approved by a vote of 5 to 0.

#### C. <u>Discussion – CalSavers</u>

California now requires that all employers with 5 or more employees provide a retirement plan for they employees. Special Districts are exempt from this requirement, but it is an opportunity to participate in a Roth IRA plan through the state run agency. The Board did not opt to participate in the CalSavers Retirement Plan.

#### D. <u>District Agent G. Payne – Monthly Report and Water Analysis January 2022</u>

The Secy./Treas. presented the District Agent's Monthly Report. December 2021 Production 736,734 Gallons.

Coliform/Fecal testing per sample site plan came back negative. Samples were taken at 590 McKinney Rubicon Springs Rd. in McKinney Estates.
