#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### A. Update – Farr West Engineering

An order for the VFD equipment has been placed with Wedco in Reno. The equipment should be delivered in July. Farr West is 90% complete with the electrical design.

### B. TCPUD – Mutual Water Aid Agreement –

The agreement has been sent to the TCPUD legal team for an update.

#### **NEW BUSINESS and MONTHLY REPORTS**

#### A. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>

The Board accepted the Treasurer's Report as presented for the month of May 2022 totaling - \$857,376.10

## B. Bills/Charges and Transfers

The Board reviewed the June 2022 Bills and Charges totaling \$47,675.78. On a motion of Director Swartfager and seconded by Director Arcidiacono the bills and charges were approved by a vote of 5 to 0.

## C. <u>Resolution 2022-4 – Budget for FY 2022-2023</u>

Resolution 2022-4 – The 2022-2023 Annual Budget was presented to the board for review and approval. See Addendum C. On a motion by Director Swartfager seconded by Director Noack Resolution 2022-4, The 2022-2023 Annual Budget was approved/denied as amended by a vote of 5 to 0.

### D. Water Bill Collection Total for 2022-2023 Billing Period

The district has received \$55,406.00 in water payments as of June 22, 2022

### E. Digitize, Destroy Archived Documents

Back in 2013, documentation was collected from the storage facility and sorted and logged in preparation for digitizing and/or shredding. All those documents have been processed. Since then, additional documentation has been accumulating. It is requested shred archived copies of water bills for 1986, 1987, 1988, and 1992.

In a motion by Director Swartfager seconded by Director Cotner, the Board has approved/denied the shredding of copies of water bills from 1986-1988 and 1992 by a vote of 5 to 0.

## F. <u>New Requirements for Small Water Systems</u>

The State Water Resources Control Board notified the District of new drought-related requirements, passed by the CA State Legislature in September 2021. The following are Drought Resilience Measures and the deadlines.

- Detect production well groundwater levels January 1, 2023
- Mutual aid organization membership January 1, 2023
- Continuous operation during power failures January 1, 2024
- Backup source of water supply or a water system intertie January 1, 2027
- Meter each service connection and monitor water loss January 1, 2032
- Meet fire flow requirements January 1, 2032
- Drought elements as part of emergency response or emergency notification plans.

## G. District Agent G. Payne - Monthly Report and Water Analysis June 2022

The Secy./Treas. presented the District Agent's Monthly Report. May 2022 Production 823,844 Gallons.

Coliform/Fecal testing per sample site plan came back negative. Samples were taken at 901 McKinney Rubicon Rd. in McKinney Estates. See Addendum A – District Agent Monthly Report for repairs, replacements, and detailed activities. For Additional Services Performed see Addendum B.
